The rivers were used as major transportation routes. Sutton slowly rebuilt after the Civil War but remained small until the timber industry and Sutton became a commercial center. Sutton is now known as a tourist town with outdoor fun, Sutton Lake and Dam, Elk River and Jeremiah Carpenter Mt. Bike Trail.*

**Living River Chapel** is a Southern Baptist Church. Pastor is Aaron M. Sligar.

They have several construction jobs to be completed on three different buildings on their property. Their main building is where the sanctuary is

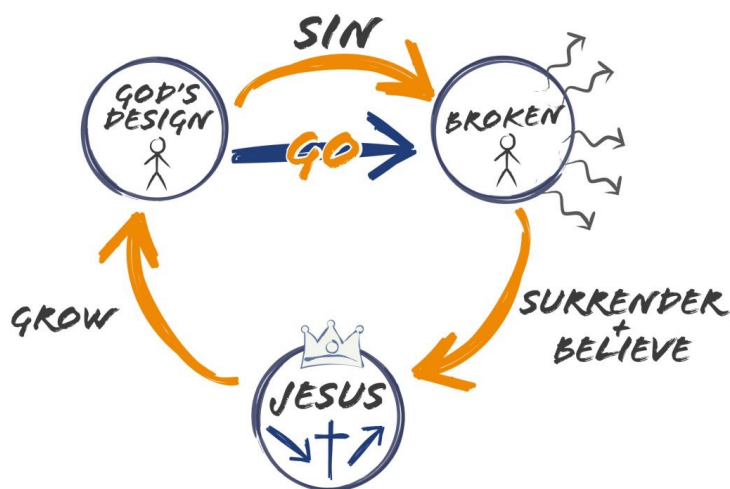
located. They also have a children's wing and a mission building.

### Construction Areas:

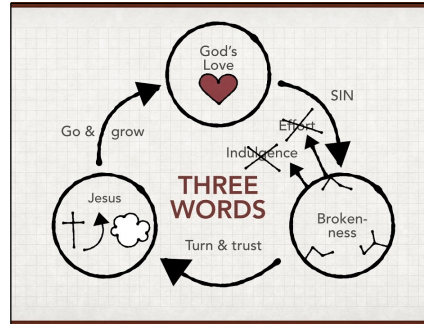
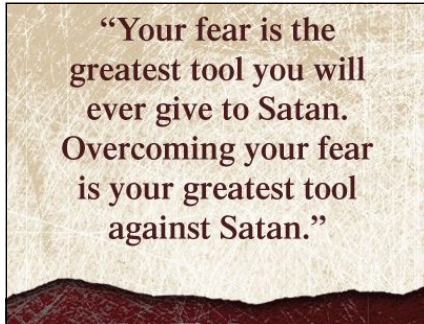
- ❖ Ceiling in Entry of Church - Drop Ceiling, moving fans and insulation
- ❖ Children's Building - Outside Painting, drywall completion and painting, ceramic tile
- ❖ Sanctuary Expansion - Removing Ceiling, adding can lights, drywall, painting, etc.
- ❖ Mission Dorm Bunks - Build 40 bunks for the two different sizes mattresses they've had donated
- ❖ Front Entrance: Create an inviting entry way into their sanctuary
